- Council agreed to table parking space in front of elementary school as letter from school has not been received. (Motion Richard, 2<sup>nd</sup> Caro, all in favor)


Public Participation:

- Citizen Mark Fisher asked for clarification were the changes on page 2 going on ballot.


- Chief Morningstar stated that the reserve academy is done and officers are now equipped with body cameras.
